

School Meeting Notes

May 1st, 2026 @ 9:30am @ Sheridan High School

- The Car Show went great!
- Dr. Mundy said he would like to hire someone to work the bathrooms on the 4th of July
- Portapotty will be rented for the 4th in addition to the restrooms at the baseball diamond and inside fieldhouse. It will be positioned by the softball diamond.
- Touch-a-truck and Emergency services located over by the gravel road on the north side of the lot.
 - Will allow for easy access to leave in case of an emergency call.
- Vendors in the parking lot and grass.
 - No power to them. They will bring generators.
- Wrestling
 - Showed them the pictures of the setup for the ring posts. Rubber mats provide protection to floor
 - Jeff and Jared request no chairs on the new floor. The audience typically stands around the ring at the park.
 - Use court 2 (far end) instead of court 1.
 - 4 or 6 roller bleachers for seating will be set out for use.
- Kid zone
 - Eric says they can take the dummies off of the football practice sleds to discourage people from climbing on them or playing with them.
 - We will put rope around them and put signs on it to keep off.
- Dunk Tank - location is good.
- Ball Drop
 - Grand park will not use the fields that day so we will be able to use them.
 - If the weather is poor or windy, it would be canceled.
 - Out of the parking lot and away from buildings.
 - Closely monitor the field and close it off when not being used.
 - Can use the power outlet near the bathrooms.
- DJ under a tent over in the kid zone.
- Main Stage located in the courtyard with a 9-piece band playing.
 - Tapping into power in the courtyard.
 - The band can use the conference room. The door will be left unlocked and we will post a sign for “band only” entrance.

- Fireworks:
 - Gates can be shut and locked in the back of the building.
 - Fireworks located on the far east side of the property and audience will sit in home bleachers to view.
 - Open the baseball diamond for blanket seating in the grass before fireworks.
 - The show will begin around 10:15 when the sun goes down.
 - Move the “10” label to on the bleachers instead of on the football field on the map
 - Can we use the sound in the stadium for the show? Access to pressbox? Dr. Mundy is unsure about finding someone to be here from the school staff. Maybe Daniel Bragg would be willing to assist that day. Dr. Mundy and Jared say if it is one of their crew, no problem using the sound.
- Work with Chief Nielsen about security that day to keep custodians from having to shoo people off the track.
- Quiet corner
 - The health room can be used.
 - Access through the old weight room door.
 - Manned through the entire event.
- Parking - We would like to shuttle people from the elementary school parking lot.
- Picnic tables spread out along the sidewalk in the front of the building.
- Support Staff
 - Jeff is going to check with his crew to see how many people would be willing to work that day.
- Concession Stand partnership
 - Lorna is interested in having it open during at least part of the event.
 - Diana said a good time would be when wrestling starts around 7 and then leading up to fireworks when people will be in the fieldhouse and football area.
- Promotional yard signs on the grassy areas of the schools were approved.
- Parade
 - The parade is still beginning in the morning.
 - The route will change to turn north on white avenue.
 - Contingency plan for parade to start later in the day if need be.
 - Carol will give Nate Mylet her cell phone number so we stay in contact in case plans change.
 - Nate requested Diana create a map of the parade route to post on social media for the Lions Club so that the community is better informed of the change in the route.
